

# QUESTIONNAIRE ON UNEMPLOYMENT



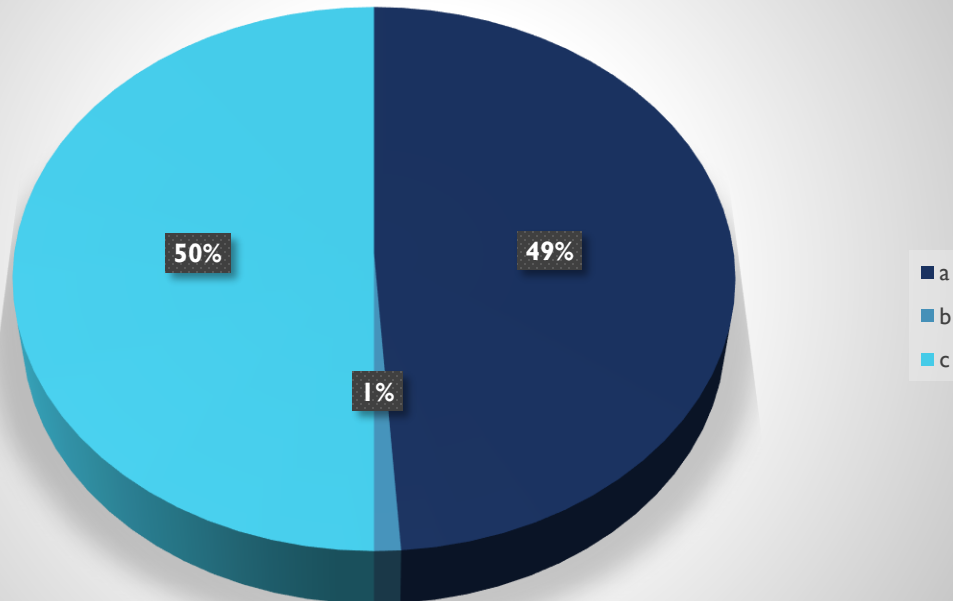
## BASIC INFORMATION ABOUT THE SURVEY

- They filled in the questionnaires in January 2016

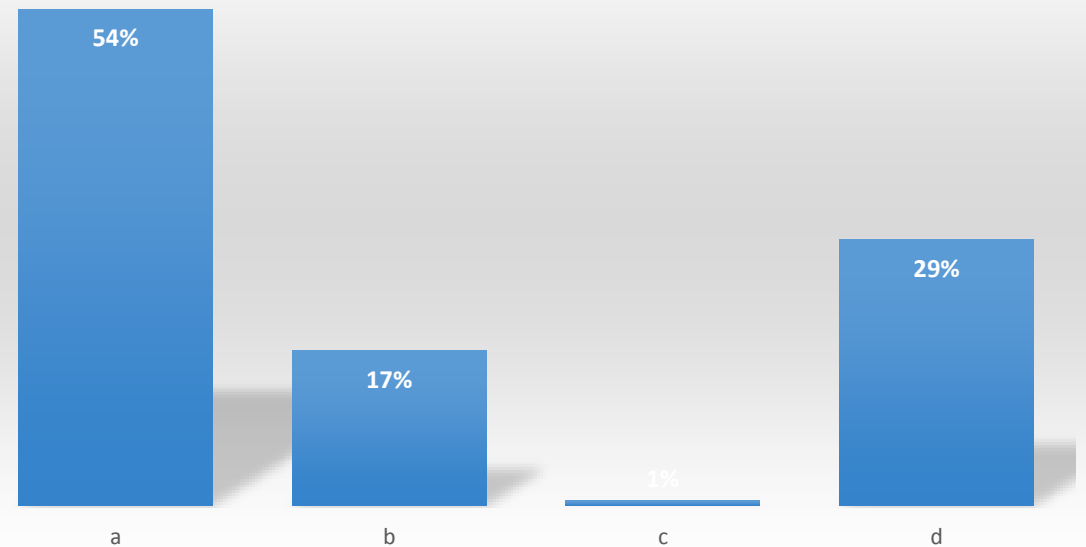
Question 1: 50% think that anyone, who does not have a job. 49% chose the first answer.

### 1. Who is an unemployed person?



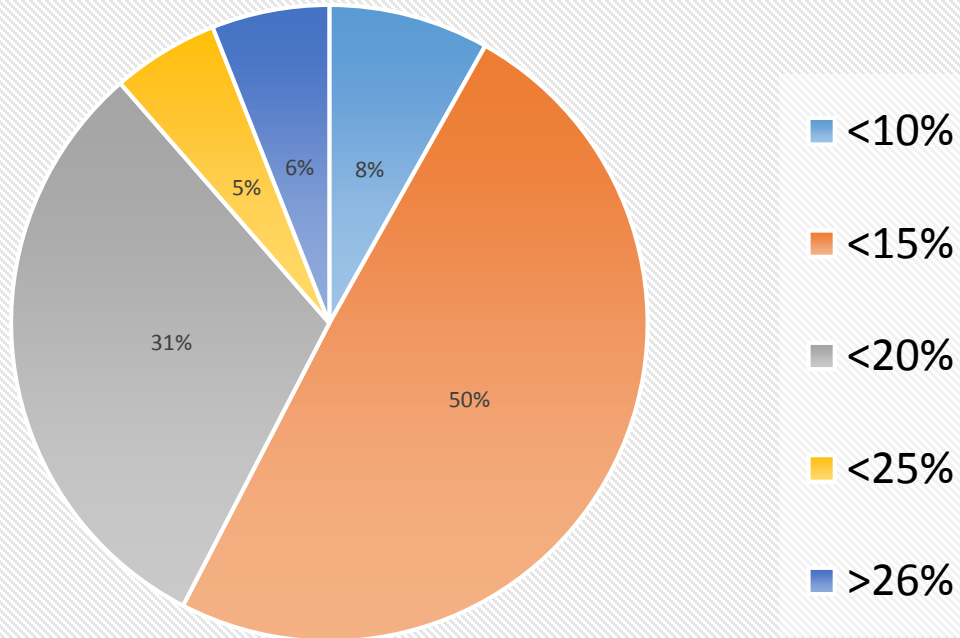
### 2. What is youth unemployment?



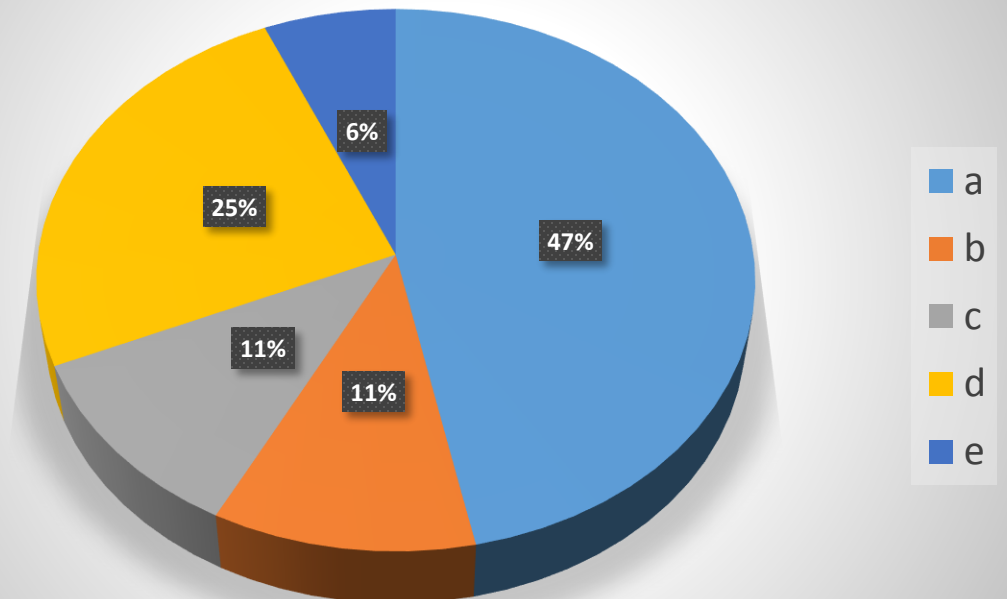
Question 3: The majority think that between 11 in 15 % of young people are unemployed, which is correct.

3. % of unemployed youth in Slovenia



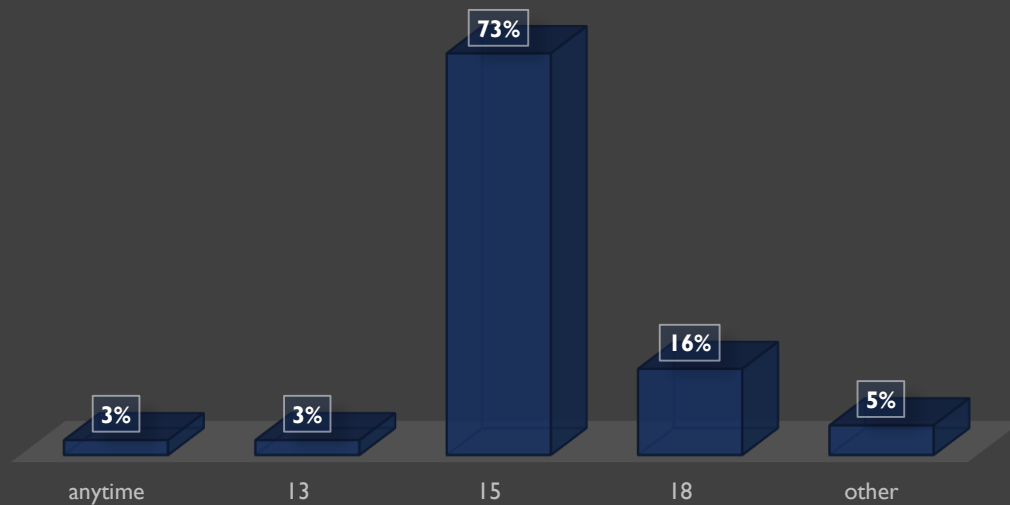
4. Why do you think youth are unemployed?



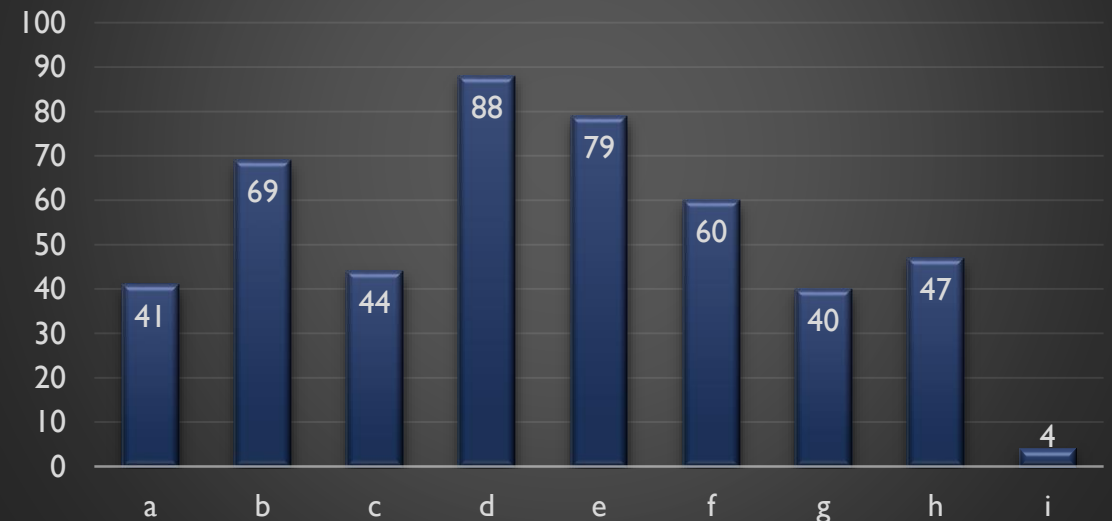
Question 5: The majority chose the correct answer for Slovenia – at the age of 15.

5. AT WHAT AGE YOUTH MAY APPLY FOR A JOB ACCORDING TO THE LAW OF YOUR COUNTRY?



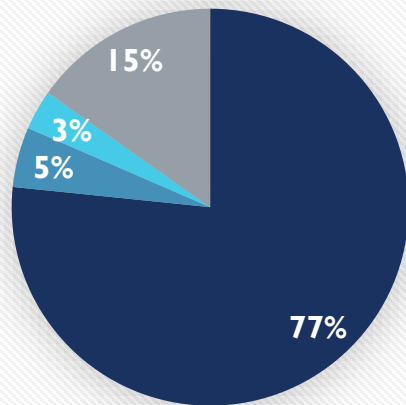

Question 7: The majority of students have heard of the state unemployment agency.

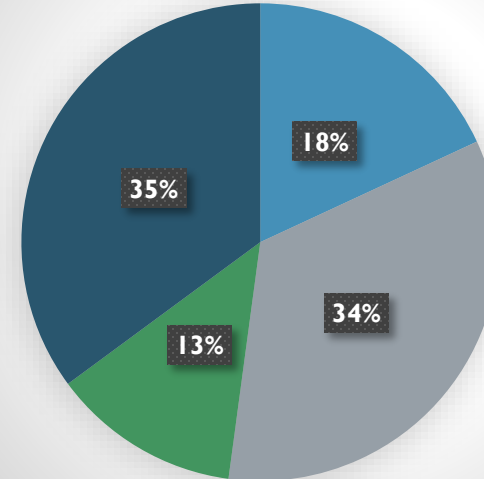
Question 8: The majority get career advice from mentors and from school councillor.

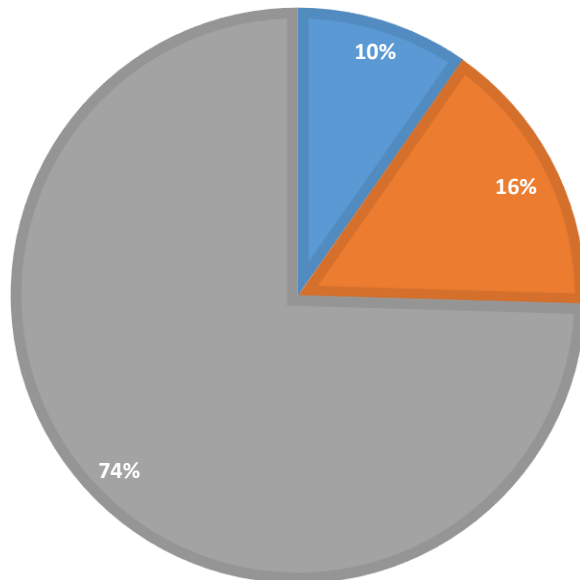

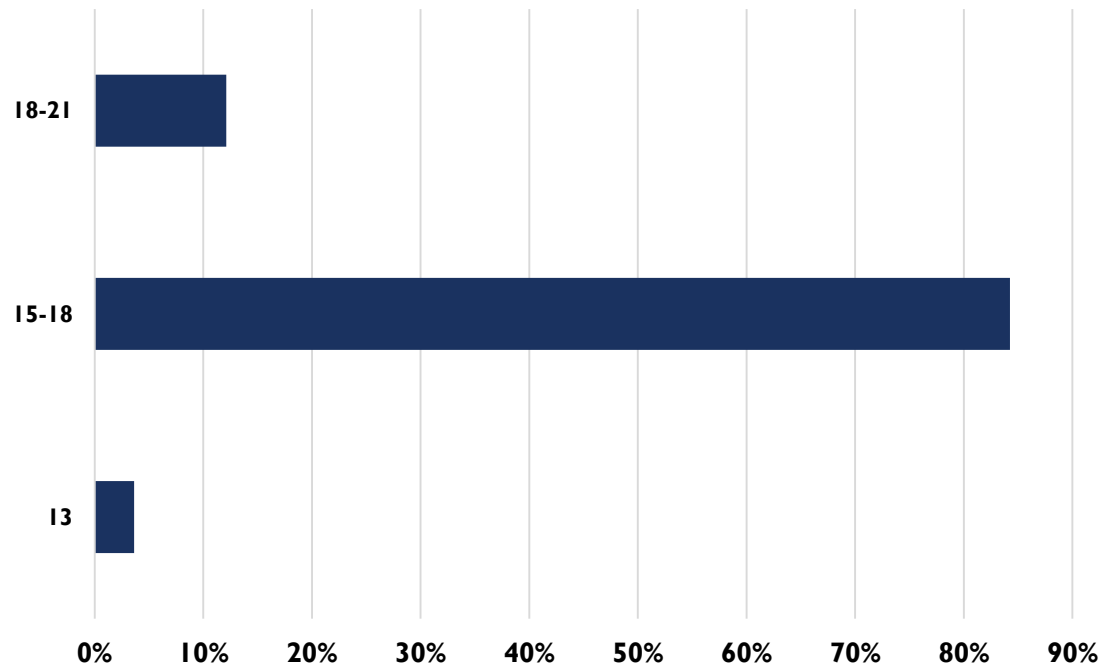

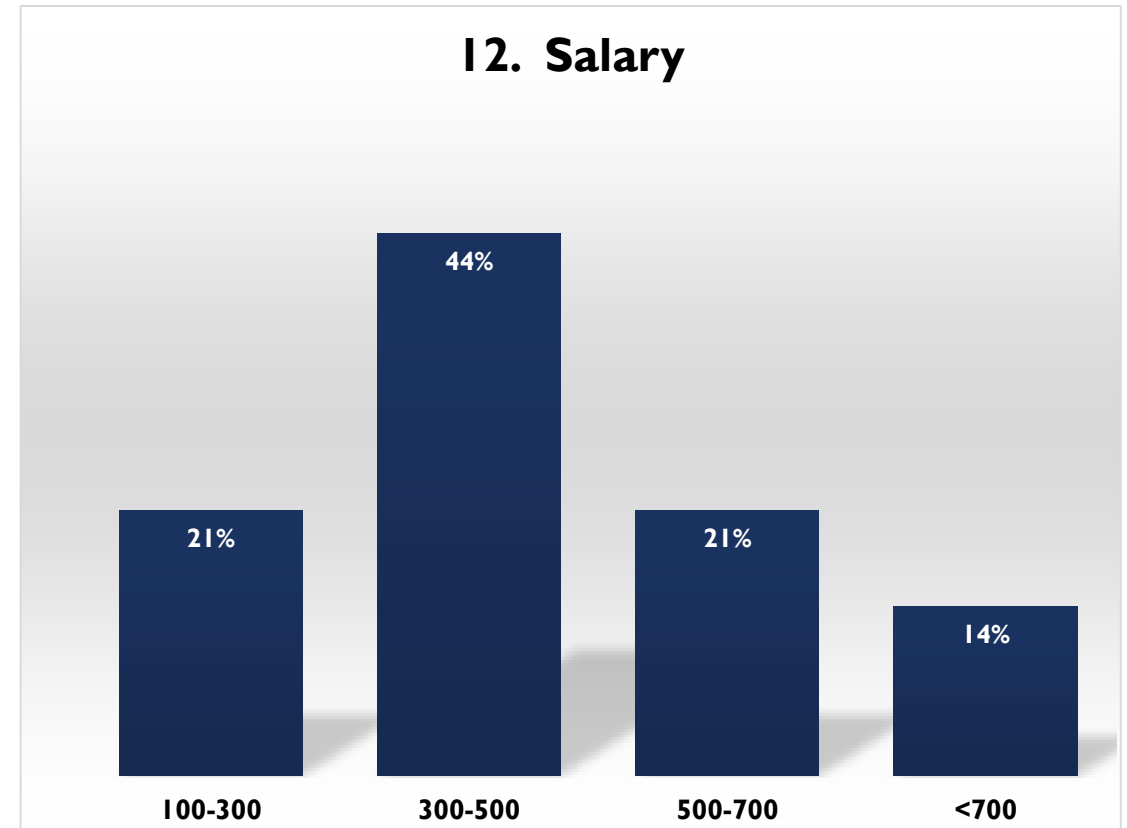

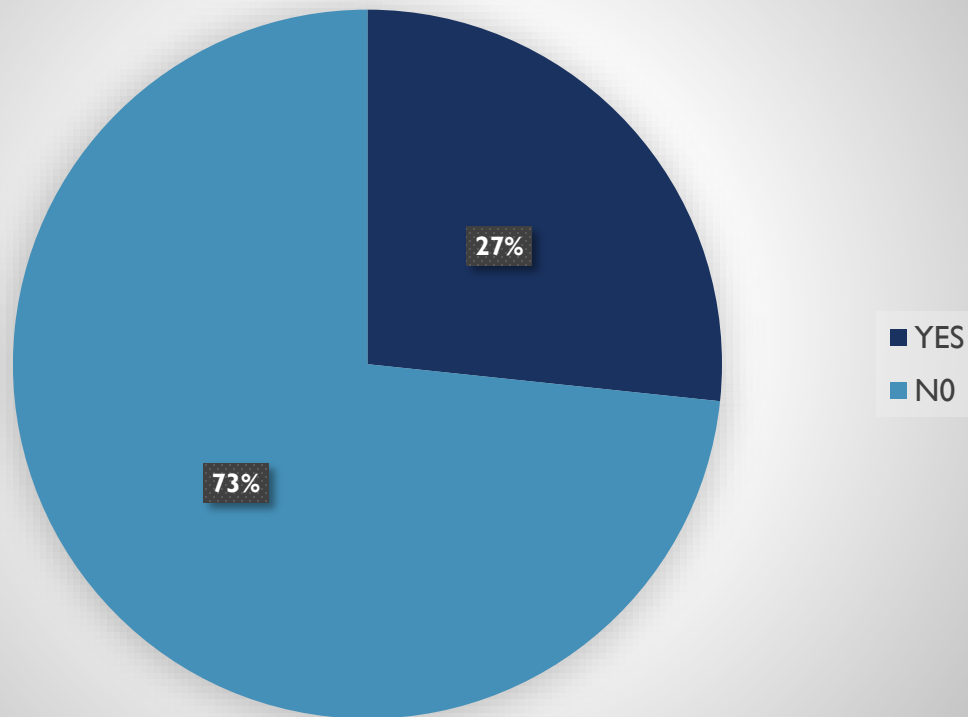




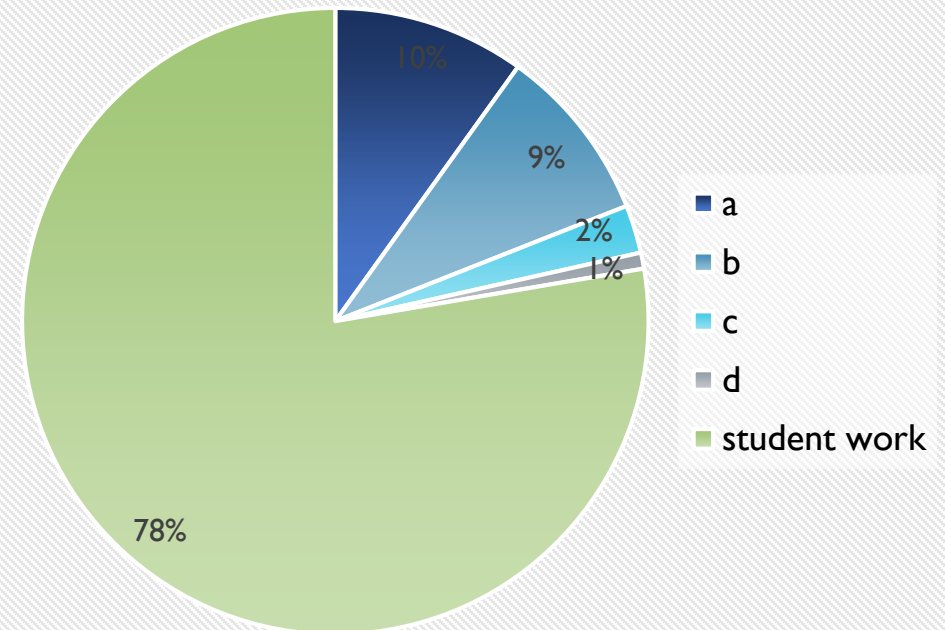

13. Official contract



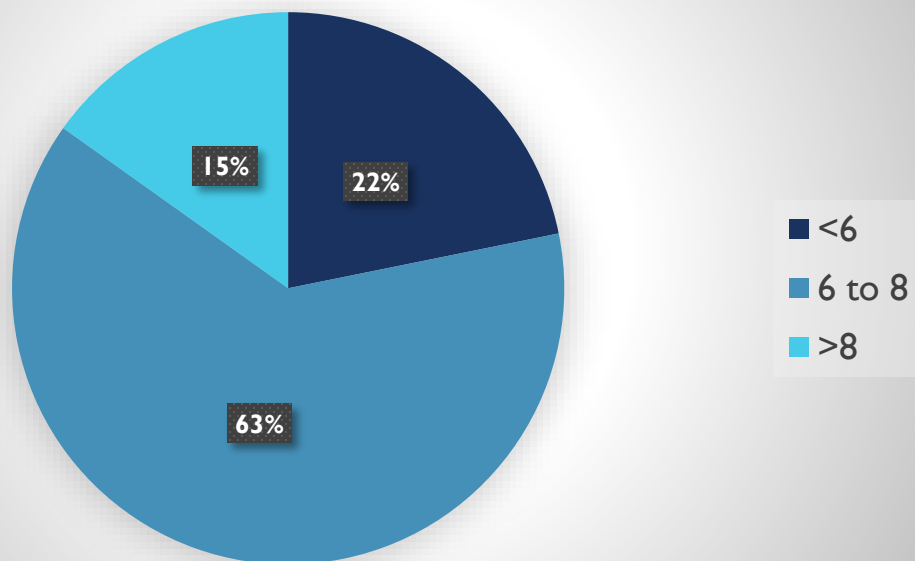

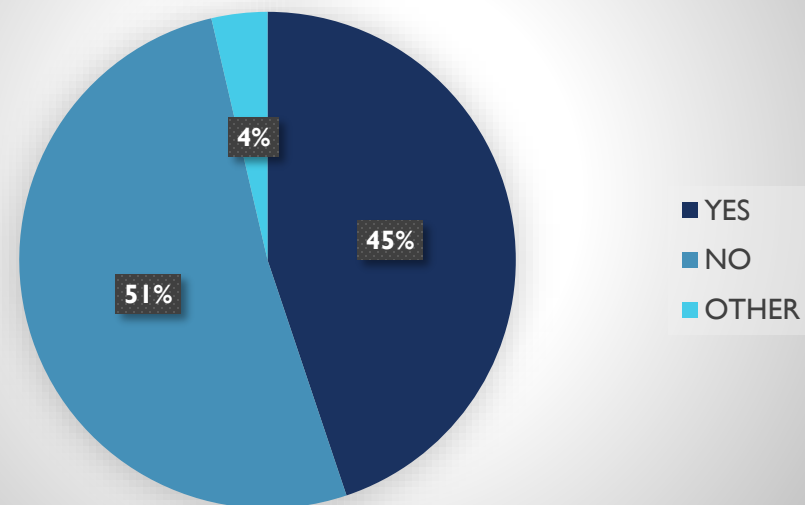

# HOW DID YOU FIND A JOB?

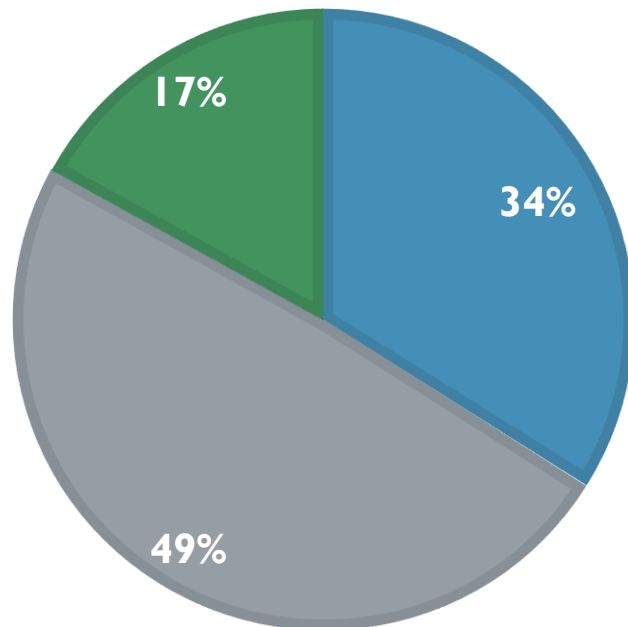
- called factory if they needed a worker

Question 17: 49 % of students is/was not happy with their job environment.

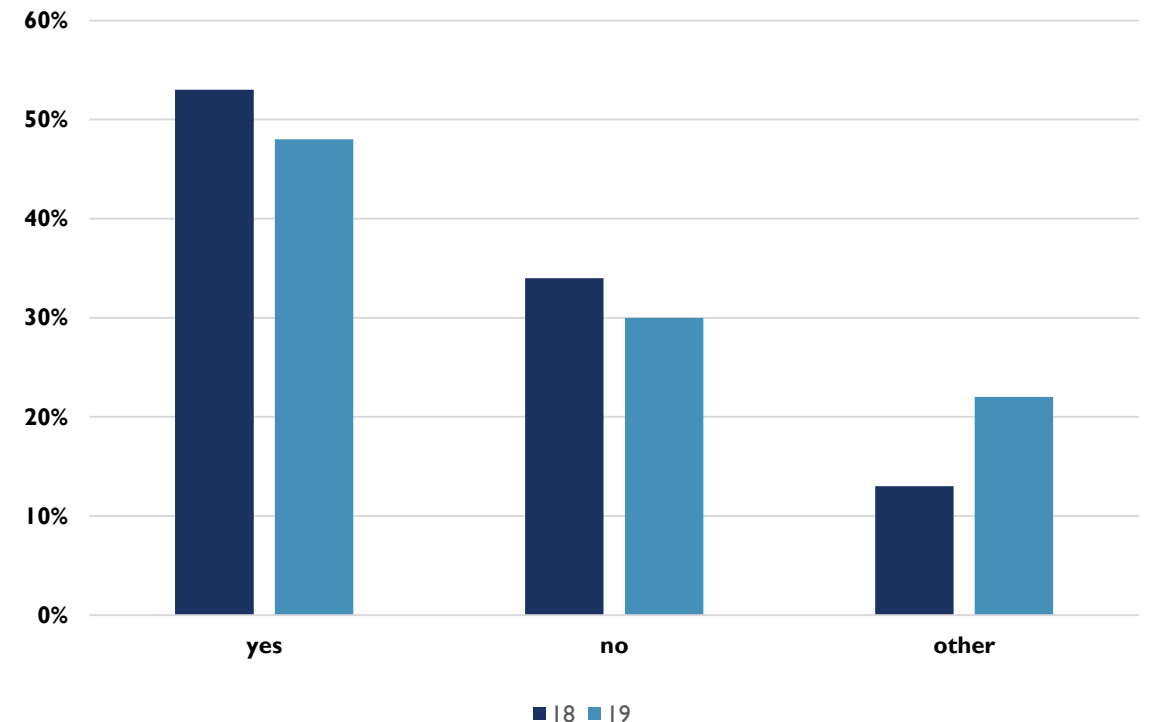
Question 18, 19: Most students manage to combine work with their studies. Mostly their employers support them.

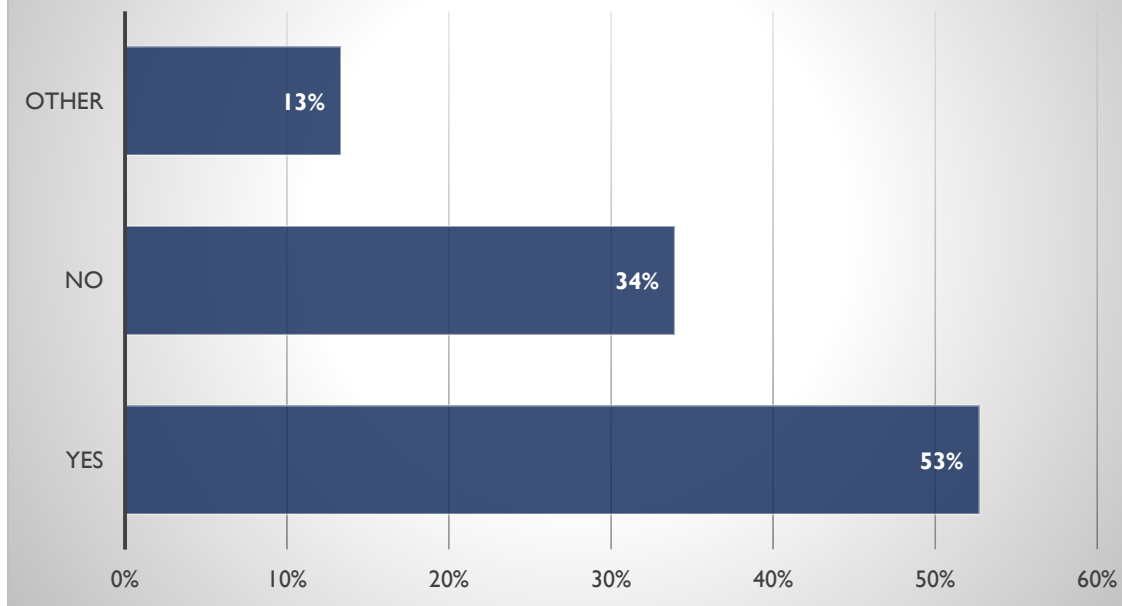


### Can you combine studying with working and does your employer support your studies?
