
■ 184 students of our school took part in the survey

Question 1: 50% think that anyone, who does not have a job. 49% chose the first answer.


Question 2: The majority chose answer 1: it includes people between the ages of 15 and 24, including people who are unemployed, who do not study and who actively search for a job;






Question 3: The majority think that between 11 in 15 % of young people are unemployed, which is correct.


Question 4: The majority think that lack of experience is the reason, 25 % think thank the young do not not know where and how to find a job.






Question 5: The majority chose the correct answer for Slovenia – at the age of 15.


Question 6: The majority think you need good communication skills, be able to work in a team, know how to present yourself.







Question 7: The majority of students have heard of the state unemployment agency.

Question 8: The majority get career advice from mentors and from school councellor.





















Question 18, 19: Most students manage to combine work with their studies. Mostly their employers support them.


17. SATISFACTION WITH JOB ENVIRONMENT
