

## REPORT OF THE 2<sup>nd</sup> MOBILITY, ANTALYA, 7<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> APRIL 2016















The 2<sup>nd</sup> mobility of the Erasmus+ (KA2) project "**Ready for our lives**" was held from 7<sup>th</sup> April 2016 to 12<sup>th</sup> April 2016 in Antalya, Turkey.

The Czech delegation from "Obchodní akademie Karviná, s.r.o" in Karviná arrived in Antalya on April 6<sup>th</sup> and departed on April 13<sup>th</sup> 2016. The delegation was composed of the project coordinator Mr. Martin Frolík, the teacher Jiří Janík and the students Mr. Lukáš Lukš and Mr. Alexandr Bílek.

The Latvian delegation from the "Riga Secondary Night Shift School n<sup>o</sup>9", arrived in Antalya on April 6<sup>th</sup> and departed on April 13<sup>th</sup> 2016. The delegation was composed from the teachers Mrs, Jana Strautmane, Mrs. Anna Bunetova and Mrs. Inara Jankovska and the students Mr. Edvards Kristofers, Mr. Lusis Lukass Klavins and Miss Daniela Strautniece.

The Portuguese delegation from the Agrupamento de Escolas Alexandre Herculano from Porto arrived in Antalya on April 6<sup>th</sup> and departed on April 13<sup>th</sup> 2016.. The delegation was composed from the headmaster Mr. Manuel Jose Lima, the teacher Mrs. Maria da Graça Guimaraes e Silva and the students Miss Neuza Pires, Mr. Simran Saini, Miss Rita İrina Silva and Miss Francisca Marques.

The Slovenian delegation from the school "Srednja ekonomsko-poslovna šola Koper" in Koper arrived in Antalya on April 6<sup>th</sup> and departed on April 13<sup>th</sup> 2016. The delegation was composed from the teachers Mrs. Nataša Jerman and Mrs. Tanja Skok and the students Miss Kaja Licen, Miss Tal Omcikus, Miss Anja Segulin, Miss Arnisa Hoxha and Mr. Denis Ferhatovic.

The Lithuanian delegation from the school "Kedainiai Sviesioji Gymnasium" in Kedainiai arrived in Antalya on April 6<sup>th</sup> and departed on April 13<sup>th</sup> 2016. The delegation was composed from the teachers Mrs. Violeta Liutkiene, Mrs. Rasa Jeckiene and Mrs. Agne Baciauskiene and the students Mr. Karolis Vainauskas, Miss Zyginta Smulkstyte and Miss Ugne Grigaityte.

The Italian delegation from the school I.I.S. "A. Volta" in Nicosia arrived in Antalya on April 6<sup>th</sup> and departed on April 13<sup>th</sup> 2016. The delegation was composed from the teachers Mrs. Maria Filippa La Porta and Mrs. Maria La Licata and the students Miss Sabrina Granata, Miss Felicia Lipari, Miss Pamela Conticello and Mr. Antonino Anello.

The organizer of the 2<sup>nd</sup> mobility was the Turkish school Özel Adalya Anadolu Lisesi.

On Wednesday April 6<sup>th</sup> all the participants were welcomed by the host teachers at the airport and then transferred to the hotel and host families.

On Thursday, April 7<sup>th</sup> all the participants gathered at school where the presentations of the Tutkish school and educational system were presented. Later on the participating schools presented their own countries, towns and schools. In the afternoon the participating schools presented their results of surveys on job interviews. Later on all the teachers and students were welcomed by the mayor of the city in the town hall in the centre of Antalya.

On Friday, April 8<sup>th</sup>, there was a seminar on job interview followed by the students' work on the topic. In the afternoon all the participants visited the Hürriyet newspaper editorial office and then they were welcomed by the Mayor of Kepez who presented this part of the city and answered several questions of the students and teachers. Then all the students, teachers, host families and representatives of the school board gathered at school for the Evening of national cuisine. The participating teams prepared their typical dishes of their countries.

On Saturday, April 9<sup>th</sup>, there was a whole day excursion which started with a typical Turkish breakfast (simit and tea) in Antalya. The participating teachers and students learned about the Turkish history and culture and visited the ancient places Phaselis, rock tombs in Myra and St.Nicholas' Church in Demre. The organizing school also arranged a blue voyage near Kekova during which the participants could see remains of an old town in the sea. After typical Turkish dinner in Finike the programme continued in Mt.Olympos where the students and teachers climbed up the hill to see chimeras. Whole day trip ended with arrival back to Antalya after midnight.

On Sunday, April 10<sup>st</sup>, the students learned about the culture, the way of life and the traditions of Turkey together with their host families while the teachers visited the most important places of interest in the centre of Antalya, in Kaleici.

On Monday, April 11<sup>th</sup> all the students and teachers gathered at the Antauya Chamber of Commerce and Industry for a seminar. After that the programme continued at school where the students showed their presentations of work on the topic of racism at the labour market. In the afternoon there was an excursion to the CANTEK company near Antalya. After arrival back at school the teachers worked on evaluation of the project run while students worked in mixed groups and prepared their role-plays on racism at the labour market and on job interviews.

On Tuesday, April 12<sup>th</sup> morning the participants visited the Antalya Museum and the old town of Kaleici where they learned about the history of the city and the region. In the afternoon the teachers had another evaluation meeting and planned the third mobility which will be held in October in Slovenia. The teachers agreed on the planned activities and tasks to be done and the methods to be used between the meetings in Turkey and Slovenia. The students. In the late afternoon all the participants were given their certificates of attendance and the 2<sup>nd</sup> mobility was officially concluded with a farewell dinner.

On Wednesday April 13th all the participants were departed to the Antalya airport.

During the 2<sup>nd</sup> mobility the teachers agreed on the tasks to be done for the 3<sup>rd</sup> exchange in Slovenia which will be held in October 2016.

- Each country will make a powerpoint presentation of the results of surveys on starting a firm and making a business plan. (5-10 minutes max.)
- Each country will make a presentation of the results of surveys on the matter of bossing in firms and companies. (5-10 minutes max.). Each country will develop their research on their own using the most appropriate methods they find the most useful.
- Each country will carry out a discussion / a debate on the matter of bossing
  with responsible people at their local authorities and on the issue of
  starting a firm and making a business plan.
- Each country will prepare a short presentation of their country, town and school to be presented during the exchange in Slovenia (5 min. maximum).
- Each country will prepare some national dishes that will be presented at the evening of national cuisine at the Slovenian school.

During the 2<sup>nd</sup> mobility the delegations also agreed on the following:

- a) The Latvian team will prepare 10 common questions for the questionnaire on starting a firm and making a business plan and the other partners can add other questions (max. 10) based on their own needs and situations. The questionnaires will be sent to partner schools by May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016.
- b) Each country will carry out a research on the issue of bossing in firms and companies to be presented during the meeting in Slovenia.
- c) Each country will prepare a presentation of their country, town and school for the meeting in Slovenia
- d) The Lithuanian school will publish the evaluation form by April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2016 and will collect the answers and work out the evaluation results by April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2016. Only the participating students and teachers will take part in this evaluation activity. The results will be published on twinspace by May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016
- e) All participating schools will send their newsletters by June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016 to the Turkish school. Maximum pages of each newsletter will be 4 pages per a school. The participating schools should use word format and picasa for their photos.
- f) The Italian school will open new pages on eTwinning so that the visitors could see the results of our work.
- g) The Czech school will upload the results of the work (presentations, questionnaires etc.) on the website and the facebook page.
- h) Each school is recommended to publish their results of work on their school web pages or school facebook pages, in local media etc. Newspaper articles will be also presented on the webpage of the project.

- The Slovenian school will send the other partners the programme of the 3<sup>rd</sup> mobility and the host families' contacts by September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2016.
- The Lithuanian school will organize a Skype conference, the exact date will be agreed by the school coordinators through email communication.
- The Slovenian school will work out the video-presentation from the meeting in Turkey to be presented at the meeting in Slovenia.
- The dates of the meeting in Slovenia will be agreed by the leaders after a discussion with their headmaster / headmistress. There are two suggestions for the dates of the meeting in Koper either from October 13 18 (with travel dates October 12 and 19) or from October 19 24 (with travel dates October 18 and 25).
- The coordinator of the project will send to the leaders a blank availability chart for the school year 2016 / 2017 to be filled in. After collecting the responses the coordinator will suggest the dates for the meetings in Lithuania and Italy.
- All schools will continually carry on with local activities of the project according to the tasks to be completed before the 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting in Koper.
- All schools will evaluate the 1<sup>st</sup> year of the project in their schools and check the budget matters (expenses spent during the 1<sup>st</sup> year of the project).

All the participants of the "Ready for our lives" project appreciate the effort, the work and the warm hospitality of the Turkish organizers of the 2<sup>nd</sup> mobility. All the participants find the activities very interesting and agree they learned a lot during the meeting. All the planned tasks and activities were fully accomplished.

The next meeting is going to be held in Koper, Slovenia in October 2016.
