

REPORT OF THE 7th MOBILITY, KARVINÁ, 8th March – 13th March, 2018



The 7th mobility of the Erasmus+ (KA2) project “**Ready for our lives**“ was held from 8th March, 2018 to 13th March, 2018 in Karviná, Czech Republic.

The **Latvian delegation** from the “Rīga Secondary Night Shift School n°9“ in Riga arrived in Karviná on March 7th and departed on March 14th, 2018. The delegation was composed of the teachers Mrs. Santa Bērziņa and Mr. Edvīns Latkovskis and the students Mr. Pēteris Matīss Cīrulis, Miss Elizabete Estere Sileniece, and Miss Anastasija Semjonova.

The **Italian delegation** from the “I.I.S. “A. Volta in Nicosia”, arrived in Karviná on March 7th and departed on March 14th, 2018. The delegation was composed of the teachers Mrs. Maria Filippa La Porta and Mr. Ferdinando Lociuro and the students Miss Federica Maria Fascetto, Mr. Giuseppe Pittalà and Mr. Giuseppe Mancuso.

The **Turkish delegation** from the school “Özel Adalya Anadolu Lisesi“ in Antalya arrived in Karviná on March 7th and departed on March 14th, 2018. The delegation was composed of the headmaster Mr. Kenan Çelik, the teachers Mrs. Funda Vuslat Mackenzie, Mr. Alper Baysal and Mr. Sencer Yilanci and the students Mr. Ozcan Isildar, Mr. Tunca Celik, Miss Zeynep Turudu and Miss Karelen Asci.

The **Portuguese delegation** from the school “Agrupamento de Escolas Alexandre Herculano” in Porto arrived in Karviná on March 7th and departed on March 14th, 2018. The delegation was composed of the headmaster Mr. Manuel Lima and the teacher Maria da Graça Guimarães Silva and the students Miss Iara Filipa Dias, Mr. Pedro Jorge Mota and Miss Sofia Alexandra Silva.

The **Slovenian delegation** from the school “Srednja ekonomsko-poslovna šola Koper” in Koper arrived in Karviná on March 7th and departed on March 14th, 2018. The delegation was composed of the teachers Mrs. Nataša Jerman and Mrs. Nataša Vrčon Tratar and the students Miss Kaja Ličen, Miss Arnisa Hohxa and Miss Valeriya Lyubchik.

The **Lithuanian delegation** from the school “Kedainiai Sviesioji Gymnasium” in Kedainiai arrived in Karviná on March 7th and departed on March 14th, 2018. The delegation was composed of the teachers Mrs. Agnė Bačiauskienė and Mrs. Rasa Jėckienė and the students Miss Barbora Mižutavičiūtė, Miss Urtė Dirdaitė and Mr. Smiltis Žilinskas.

The organizer of the 7th mobility was the Czech school Obchodní akademie, s.r.o in Karviná.

On Wednesday March 7th, in the evening, all the participants were welcomed by the project coordinator Mr. Martin Frolík and the teacher Mrs. Zdeňka Parchanská at the railway station, and then the students were transferred to host families and the teachers to the hotel.

On Thursday, March 8th, all the participants gathered at Regional library where the welcome ceremony took place followed by the presentation of the Czech school, the presentation of the Czech system of education and the presentations of the partner schools. Slovenian team then showed the film “Memories from Latvia” about the previous meeting. After lunch the programme continued at school. The participating schools presented their results of the questionnaire on the topic of other aspects of entrepreneurship. The foreign students spent their evening with their host families, while the teachers had a common dinner.

On Friday, March 9th, the foreign teachers and students went for an excursion to the Marlenka company, a firm which was established by an Armenian man who emigrated to the Czech Republic and developed his business here. After lunch, the workshop “A man or a woman” took place at school. The participating schools presented their films, presentations and role-plays on this topic. Then the students spent the rest of the afternoon with host families and the teachers went for a short excursion to Ostrava to see the most important places in the region.

On Saturday, March 10th, the students learned about the history, culture, the way of life and traditions of the Czech Republic together with their host families.

On Sunday, March 11th, the participants gathered in front of the school and set out for an excursion trip focused on other aspects of entrepreneurship. First, we visited the eco-farm Zerlina in Hážovice where the participants learned about ecological farming, restrictions and rules they have to follow. They also saw milking goats and tasted some milk products the eco-farm produces. The second firm we visited was a small producer of candles. In the afternoon the programme continued in Rožnov pod Radhoštěm where the participants learned about traditions and the way of life of the people in this region in history in the “Wooden village”. Afterwards the participants were taken to Pustevny hill to see traditional wooden houses.

On Monday, March 12th, there was a meeting in Karviná chateau with responsible people from the municipality. The participants were welcomed by Mr. Karel Wiewiórka and a short discussion about the project followed. Afterwards the participants were guided round the chateau and learned more about history of Karviná. In the afternoon, the teachers and students visited the “World of technique” in Ostrava and in the evening the teachers had an informal meeting.

On Tuesday, March 13th, the students had a workshop on discrimination because of gender at labour market while the teachers had an evaluation meeting where they discussed the activities done in Karviná, checked and evaluated the whole run of the project and planned the transnational meeting in Portugal. The afternoon programme included a short visit of two important churches in Karviná and then in the evening, all the participants were taken to Horní Suchá for a farewell dinner. After cultural

performance of a folk dance group “Vonička” the coordinator of the project, Mr. Martin Frolík had an official speech where he made a sum up of the whole three-year project. The participants could look back to all the previous meetings and to the whole run of the project. Then the official ceremony followed and the headmistress of the Czech school, Mrs. Slavka Krystová Florková handed out the certificates of attendance to all participants of the meeting. The seventh project meeting was successfully concluded.

On Wednesday, March 14th, the delegations left Karviná for their home countries.

During the 7th mobility the teachers agreed on the tasks to be done for the transnational meeting which will be held from **8th May to 11th May, 2018** (with travel days on 7th May and 12th May).

- Each country will carry out an evaluation of the project run, its activities, outputs and results through personal meetings, questionnaires and other evaluation methods.
- Each country will summarize their project work at the local level and gather all the outputs and results of the project work.
- Each country will prepare a powerpoint presentation of the local activities done during the project.
- Each country will bring the outputs and results and any other important materials for the successful completion of the project and for the final report to the transnational meeting in Porto.
- The Lithuanian school will publish the evaluation form by March 31st, 2018 and will collect the answers and work out the evaluation results by **April 15th, 2018**. For this evaluation, the eTwinning platform will be used. Only the participating students and teachers will take part in this evaluation. The results will be published on twinspace by **April 30th, 2018**.
- All participating schools will send their newsletters by April 25th, 2018 to the Turkish school. Maximum pages of each newsletter will be 4 pages per a school. The participating schools should use word format and picasa for their photos.
- The Italian school will update the pages on eTwinning so that the visitors could see the results of our work.
- The Czech school will upload the results of our work (presentations, questionnaires etc.) on the website and the facebook page.
- Each school is recommended to publish their results of work on their school web pages or school facebook pages, in local media etc. Newspaper articles will be also presented on the webpage of the project.
- The Portuguese school will send the other partners the programme of the transnational meeting by April 20th, 2018.
- The Lithuanian school will organize a Skype conference; the exact date will be agreed by the school coordinators.

- The Italian school will organize an e-Twinning video conference; the exact date will be agreed by the school coordinators.
- The Slovenian school will work out the video-presentation from the meeting in the Czech Republic to be presented at the transnational meeting in Portugal.
- The leaders of the participating schools will check their access to their Mobility Tool and in case of any problems they will contact their National Agencies and will also inform the coordinator of the project.
- The leaders of the participating schools confirmed once again the dates of the transnational meeting in Porto. The four-day meeting will be held from 8th May to 11th May, 2018 (with travel dates 7th and 12th May, 2018)




The final meeting of the coordinators and school representatives is going to be held in Porto, Portugal in May 2018.












