

REPORT OF THE 2nd TRANSNATIONAL MEETING, PORTO, 8th - 11th MAY 2018















The 2nd transnational meeting of the Erasmus+ (KA2) project "Ready for our lives" was held from 8th May 2018 to 11th May 2018 in Porto, Portugal.

The Czech delegation from "Obchodní akademie, s.r.o" in Karviná arrived in Porto on May 7th and departed on May 12th 2018. The delegation was composed of the headmistress Mrs.Slavka Krystová Florková, and the teacher and coordinator of the project, Mr.Martin Frolík.

The Latvian delegation from the "Riga Secondary Night Shift School n°9", arrived in Porto on May 7th and departed on May 12th 2018. The delegation was composed of the headmistress, Mrs.Ilze Dupate, the teachers Mrs.Santa Bērziņa, Mrs.Inese Lapiņa Irbe and Mrs. Ināra Jankovska.

The Turkish delegation from the school "Özel Adalya Anadolu Lisesi" in Antalya arrived in Porto on May May 7th and departed on May 12th 2018. The delegation was composed of from the headmaster Kenan Celik, and the teacher Mrs.Funda Vuslat Mackenzie.

The Italian delegation from the school I.I.S. "A. Volta" in Nicosia arrived in Porto on May 7th and departed on May 12th 2018. The delegation was composed of the headmaster Mr.Felice Lipari and the teacher Mrs.Maria Filippa La Porta.

The organizer of the 2nd transnational meeting was the Portuguese school Agrupamento de Escolas Alexandre Herculano" in Porto.

On Monday, May 7th all the participants were welcomed by the teachers of the Portuguese school at the airport and then transferred to the hotel.

On Tuesday, May 8th, there was a welcoming ceremony followed by the exhibition of the "Ready for our lives project" prepared by the host school. Later on, there was a common meeting with all delegations where the participating teachers compared the submitted application form to the results achieved during the project and discussed the activities, mobilities, results and outputs of the project. In the evening all teachers had a welcoming dinner at a restaurant.

On Wednesday, May 9th the teachers evaluated the project run and all the mobilities during nonformal discussions held on the way to Régua. The participating teachers also discussed future cooperation in international projects, particularly Erasmus+.

On Thursday May 10th the teachers met again at school to continue with the project work. Another check of the activities and outputs planned and done was held, presentations, videos and other materials were gathered. Afterwards a check of Mobility tools was done and the teachers discussed and solved problems with the Mobility Tool. In the afternoon the teachers visited a Museum of contemporary art in Porto and Clérigos Tower.

Friday, May 11th was devoted to nonformal activities and discussions over the plan of dissemination activities in each school as well as learning about the host country (Viana do Castelo and Valença do Minho).

During the 2nd transnational mobility the teachers

- evaluated the whole run of the project
- concluded the work on the project, presented outputs and agreed on ways of dissemination of the results and outputs
- discussed and evaluated the workshops, outputs, results, contribution and added value to the schools
- evaluated the involvement of the students and teachers in the project
- evaluated the contribution of the project to public
- shared gained experience with the other teachers participating at the meeting
- discussed future cooperation among the schools and sustainability of the project for the future

agreed on the tasks to be done till the end of the project:

- Each country will do the evaluation of the project in their school according to the plan given in the application form.
- Each country will make up a plan of dissemination activities
- The coordinator will work out a common detailed plan of dissemination and evaluation activities once he receives the plans from partner schools
- Each country will update/complete the Mobility Tool
- All participating countries will prepare all necessary materials, outputs, information for the final report.
- The coordinator will work out the list of things to be done and deadlines

All the participants of the "Ready for our lives" project agreed that the run of the transnational meeting was very good and smooth, without any serious problems and

they enjoyed the participation in the project. All the participants found the cooperation very good.

This meeting was the last meeting of the "Ready for our lives" project.
